If you would like, bike to the Gasthaus Bavarian Hunter restaurant. There are multiple entry points to the Gateway Trail which connects to the Brown's Creek Trail.

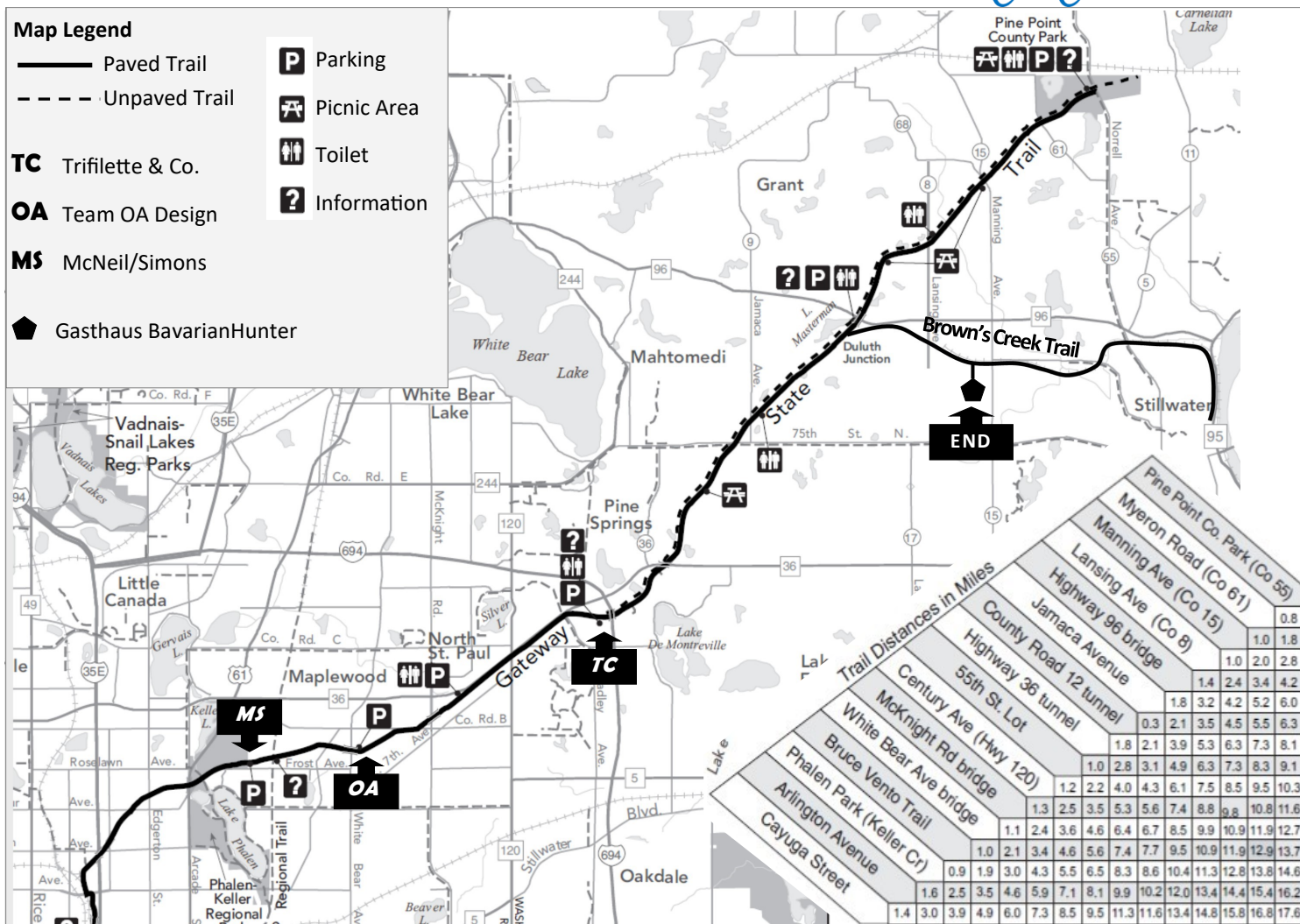
Bike as little or as long as you would like. You are welcome to join one of the groups below or to create your own at a different starting point or time.

Trifilette and Company (TC): Leaving the 55th Street Lot off of Hadley Avenue, near the South West intersection of Highway 36 and Interstate 694 at 11:15 for a 6.7 mile ride to the Gasthaus.

Team OA Design + Build (OA): Will leave the Gateway Trail parking lot at the Maplewood Community Center, south of the intersection of County Road B and White Bear Ave., at 11:00. It is a 10.5 mile ride to the Gasthaus (21 miles round trip).

McNeil & Simons Party (MS): Will bike 31 miles, 50 kilometers and a semi-round trip setting off at 9:30 from Flicek Park in Maplewood on Frost Ave (west of English St.). They will arrive at the 55 St. Lot (near Highway 36) around 10:45 and at Pine Point Park around 11:15, before reaching the Gasthaus at 12:00. They'll leave Gasthaus at 3:00 to return to Flicek Park.
